The following changes were made to the Bylaws at the Convention:

Article V Officers and Duties of Officers

Section E. The Treasurer shall:

2. Be custodian of all funds of the Association.

Article VII Meetings

Section 1. A. The Annual Association Convention shall be held the **last weekend in April** or the first week in May, unless otherwise determined by the Executive Committee.

Standing Rule Change

1. The budget shall include a line item designated as the Convention Fund. A sum of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) shall be advanced annually from the Association to the Convention Arrangements Chairman to cover incidental costs of the annual convention of the Association. Checks for convention registration and meals shall be made payable to and deposited VSAP account. The hotel contract shall be signed by the president. When convention expenses exceed the advanced amount (\$600.00)

additional monies may be requested, in writing, from this fund by the host unit, subject to the approval of the Executive Committee.
