Another opportunity for you is to nominate a member of VSAP for the Lifetime Achievement Award. All the information is at the end of this newsletter.



Lifetime Achievement Award

Purpose

The Lifetime Achievement Award, VSAP's most prestigious award, honors and recognizes a current or former VSAP member who has made extraordinary contributions, or a significant and lasting impact in the study and application of parliamentary procedure, has earned the respect and admiration of fellow VSAP members, and has engaged frequently with the community in providing outstanding service in conducting effective meetings and conveying the importance of constructive and efficient communication.

Eligibility

The Lifetime Achievement Award is intended for the individual who has been a VSAP member at least five years, and has had a significant impact on the organization, directly or indirectly. The individual must have exemplified the values and practices of VSAP/NAP and respect for human dignity.

General Award Criteria

A completed typewritten application must be submitted showing how the nominee has made a meaningful contribution to VSAP, as demonstrated by leadership skills, interpersonal skills, teaching, mentoring, blogging or sharing information with members and the community, articles published, and global or national recognition for contributions.

The required application and any supporting materials must be submitted by the due date of April 10, 2021. Incomplete nomination packets will not be reviewed.

Nominations

Active VSAP members are invited to nominate an individual they think is deserving of a Lifetime Achievement Award through the official nomination application process.

Self-nominations are accepted.

Selection Criteria

An evaluation panel will read, review, and rate the applications.

The award recipient will be notified by mid-April. An official announcement will be made in the upcoming edition of the Gaveletter.

When Award is To Be Given

The award may be given annually, biannually, or at other times. To ensure that the award remains a special award and is presented to individuals who have made outstanding achievements, and not merely an annual event, the award will be presented in a year as determined by the Board of Directors. The award may be presented posthumously.

Award presentation

The Honoree will be acknowledged at the VSAP Annual Convention or other appropriate venue as determined by the VSAP Board of Directors. A public announcement or publicity may be made prior to the convention.

The Honoree will be presented a recognition gift, plaque, or certificate.
