With no objection, the Standing Rules were not read. Rhiannon Liker, Chair of the Standing Rules Committee, presented the Proposed Standing Rules, which were adopted by voice vote. President Baer called for unanimous consent that voting be done by voice vote.

Beatrice Squire, RP, Chair of the Program Committee, presented the program which was adopted by voice vote.

President Baer referred the attendees to review the previously emailed Reports of Officers, Standing Committees, Special Committees, Units, and Clubs at their leisure.
